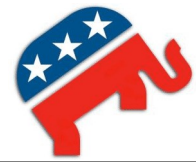

Become a voting member of the **Oregon Republican Party** Request appointment as a **Precinct Committee Person (PCP)**

You should apply to be a PCP if you:

- Care passionately about today's issues, your community and your government.
- See a need to do something about who leads your Party and your community.
- Like to stay informed about issues, Party events, personally meet candidates and Party leaders.
- Want to 'put a face' on the Republican Party in your neighborhoods and community, elect local leadership, and help set the Party agenda in Linn County.
- Wish to assist in the election of leaders who will serve with integrity and share your Republican values.

What are the special powers & responsibilities?

- Represent Republicans in your precinct to the local Republican Party and vice versa.
- Attend monthly county Republican Party "Central Committee" meetings.
- Vote on official Party business and resolutions of local interest and concern.
- Elect (every two years) county Party leadership*. Delegates to the State Platform Convention; and (every four years) Congressional District Party Leadership, Oregon delegates to the Republican National Convention. (*you must be an elected PCP to vote for county leadership)
- Nominate replacement legislators for appointment by the county commissioners and replacement Republican nominees for candidates that withdraw after the primary.

What is the PCP term of office?

Persons desiring to become a PCP after the May primary (even numbered years) may apply at anytime by completing this form and attending the Linn County Republican Central Committee (LCRCC) meeting. The LCRCC will review your eligibility and vote on approval of your appointment. Your term will continue until June of the even numbered year following your appointment. Please note, persons appointed as PCPs are not eligible to vote for the election of any officers during the bi-annual election (November of even numbered years) of officers or for replacement of officers if a vacancy occurs.

After the primary election, PCPs are appointed by the county Central Committee to fill vacant county precinct slots in either their home precinct or adjacent precinct. Persons interested in becoming a PCP must be a registered Republican for a minimum of 180 days prior to election or appointment.

Qualifications

Be a registered Republican in Oregon for a minimum of 180 days and be willing to attend at least four meetings per year as well as volunteer time to help elect Republicans to office. Other volunteer opportunities are: staffing the GOP booth at the Linn County Fair, the campaign office during election season, as well as serving on various committees. We ask for about 2 hours a month, everyone's schedule is different.

- Election filing to become an elected PCP
- (ask for dates early in January)
- PCP elections in MAY
- accompanies Congressional and Presidential primary races.
- CAMPIGN OFFICE opens last 3 months before an election – volunteers welcome!
- November elections for Local, State & Federal offices
- November (after election) County Party elections for new County officers & delegates to State Central Committee.

Odd numbered years

- January, election of State Party Officers
- Spring, file & run for many Local offices.
- Late Summer, State Party Platform Convention
